

Town Boards – Rachel Corns

Rachel Corns is Vice Principal Curriculum and Performance at Dudley College of Technology.

The college is a large general further education college, supporting around 11,000 students per year. This includes young people, adults and apprentices. Employing around 800 staff the college offers provision from Dudley Learning Quarter and Brierley Hill Learning Quarter.

More recently, the College led on the development of Innovation Park, where the Institute of Technology is based. This park is a collaboration with higher education and private training providers to bring degree level training opportunities to Dudley and the construction of Health Innovation Dudley (funded through Towns Fund) is progressing well.

Rachel was born in the Black Country and is passionate about providing opportunities for local people.

She has worked at the college for over 20 years, holding the role of Vice Principal since February 2025. Rachel has held several roles within college, Lecturer, Curriculum Manager, Head of Learning, Assistant Principal.
